**FY10 – 14 Tenaska Virginia Generating Station Modification of VPDES Permit**

The Department of Environmental Quality proposes to modify Tenaska Virginia Generating Station's permit to release cooling water into the Rivanna River in Fluvanna County in the Lower Rivanna River/Ballinger Creek watershed and the Middle Fork Cunningham Creek in Fluvanna County in the Cunningham Creek watershed. The modification of the permit consists of adding Outfall 004 which will discharge to the Rivanna River. The permit will limit pollutants to amounts that protect water quality: chlorine, pH, temperature, and chlorides. The permit and monitoring records have been requested but not received yet.

Public Comment Period: 30 days following first public notice issue date

**FY10 – 15 Department of Environmental Quality grant application for Federal funding assistance**

DEQ is applying to the State and Indian Tribal Response Program for \$355,300 (no match) to survey and inventory brownfield sites in the state. The grant program is administered by the EPA to establish and enhance state response programs that address the assessment, cleanup and redevelopment of brownfield sites and other contaminated sites as defined by law.
