FY10 – 16 Reissuance of VPDES Permit No. VA0055000, Crozet WTP

The Rivanna Water & Sewer Authority has applied to the DEQ for reissuance of the referenced permit. The applicant proposes to release treated water treatment plant wastewater at a rate of 0.186 million gallons per day into Beaver Creek Reservoir, UT in Albemarle County in the Mechums river watershed. The permit will limit the following pollutants to amounts that protect water quality: solids, chlorine, and pH. Water treatment plant solids from the treatment process will be pumped and hauled to the Moores Creek regional STP. Changes to permit conditions include removing monitoring requirements for copper, lead, and zinc based upon extensive monitoring performed by the permittee and changes made at the plant. There was one violation on record from the current permit term, 2005 to date, for total residual chlorine in November 2005.

Public Comment Period: 30 days following first public notice issue date

FY10 – 17 Environmental Impact Review (EIR): Biscuit Run Tract Acquisition

DCR submitted an EIR to the DEQ as required by the Virginia Code for acquisition of property for construction projects exceeding \$500,000. DCR proposes to acquire a 1,200 acre property, referred to as the Biscuit Run property, or Forest Lodge Land Trust Tract located in Albemarle County, South of Charlottesville, for establishment of a state park. The need for a state park in the vicinity of Charlottesville was identified in the 2007, 2002, and 1996 Virginia Outdoors Plans. The EIR addresses only the acquisition. Further EIRs may be required after DCR approves a master plan for the property.
