

Transportation Planner II.

The Transportation Planner II will be a member of the agency's transportation planning team and will take the lead on transportation planning activities and projects for both the [Charlottesville-Albemarle MPO](#) as well as a five county [rural transportation](#) planning region. The Transportation Planner II will work on a variety of transportation planning tasks including but not limited to: development of transportation plans for all modes, access management plans, bike and pedestrian facilities planning, transit plans and studies, traffic impact analysis, HCM intersection analysis, traffic data collection and travel demand modeling. Skills and experience in project management, quantitative analysis, written and oral communications are necessary. Preference will be given to candidates possessing experience with GIS and/or travel demand modeling. A bachelor's degree in planning or a related field and three to five years of experience is required. A master's degree in a transportation planning related field is preferred.
